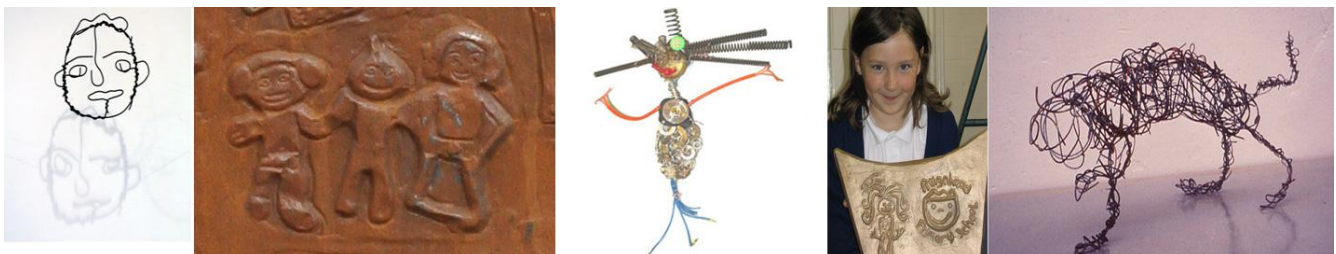

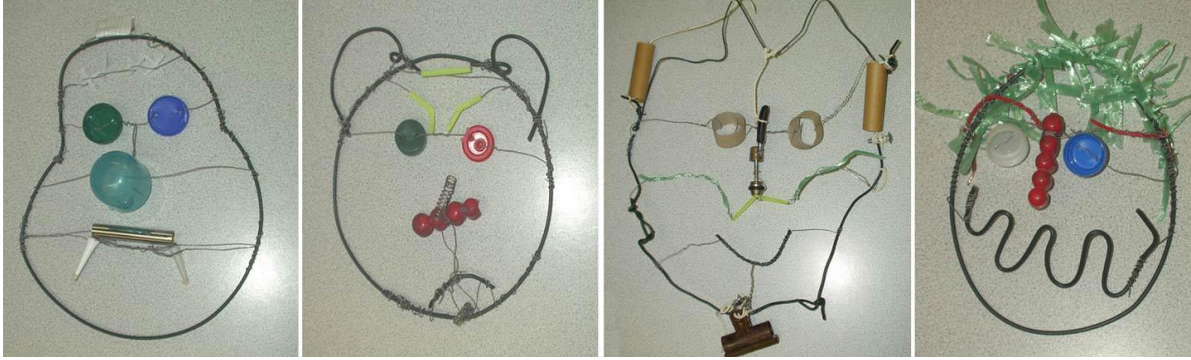

He has also run inset training sessions for teachers, child-care workers and other local authority employees.

Work in school can range from a simple talk/presentation to a workshop session or even the creation of a permanent piece of artwork that will last for many years. There is an emphasis on self sustaining projects and development of skills and techniques that that can easily be learnt and passed on to others.
